There are some very old buildings at the above farms which require major repair & maintenance and boundary walls. As such presently the above buildings does not ful fill the requirement of the SSC, hence there is a requirement of new buildings for storage, office accommodation and residential purpose.

## GRANT-IN-AID TO SSC

- As per PC-I of the Revival / Rehabilitation of SSC, the funds required for salaries and day to day expenses will be provided by the Government of Sindh through Grant-in-Aid as per past practice. The detail of Grant-in-Aid provided by the Government since 1994-95 is given below:-

- The Deficit mentioned from the year 1994-95 to 2005-06 was met out / adjusted from the income of Farm and marketing of seed.
- Necessary requisition for providing of funds in shape of Grant-in-Aid, to the tune of Rs.39.854 millions has been sent to the Government, but only Rs. 17.00 millions have yet been provided by the Government. As such presently there are no funds for salaries of employees and day to day / general expenses i.e. POL of vehicles, payment of Electricity / Telephone bills, Printing and stationery, Medical Reimbursement, Legal Expenses, Audit fee etc etc.

It is submitted that as per past practice, the Government of Sindh make a provision of Rs. 17.00 millions as Grant-in-Aid in their budget estimates since 1994-95. However the Government has met out the additional requirement of SSC from outside budget estimates by floating a summary to the Chief Minister Sindh. The Agriculture Department has floated a summary for the honourable Chief Minister Sindh for provision of additional requirement of Rs. 22.854 millions to the SSC, through the Finance Department Government of Sindh, but the same is still pending without any action.
